◆ European Union becomes reality !!!

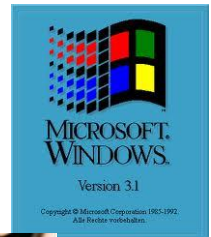
- Single Market created → “Maastrich Treaty” enforced

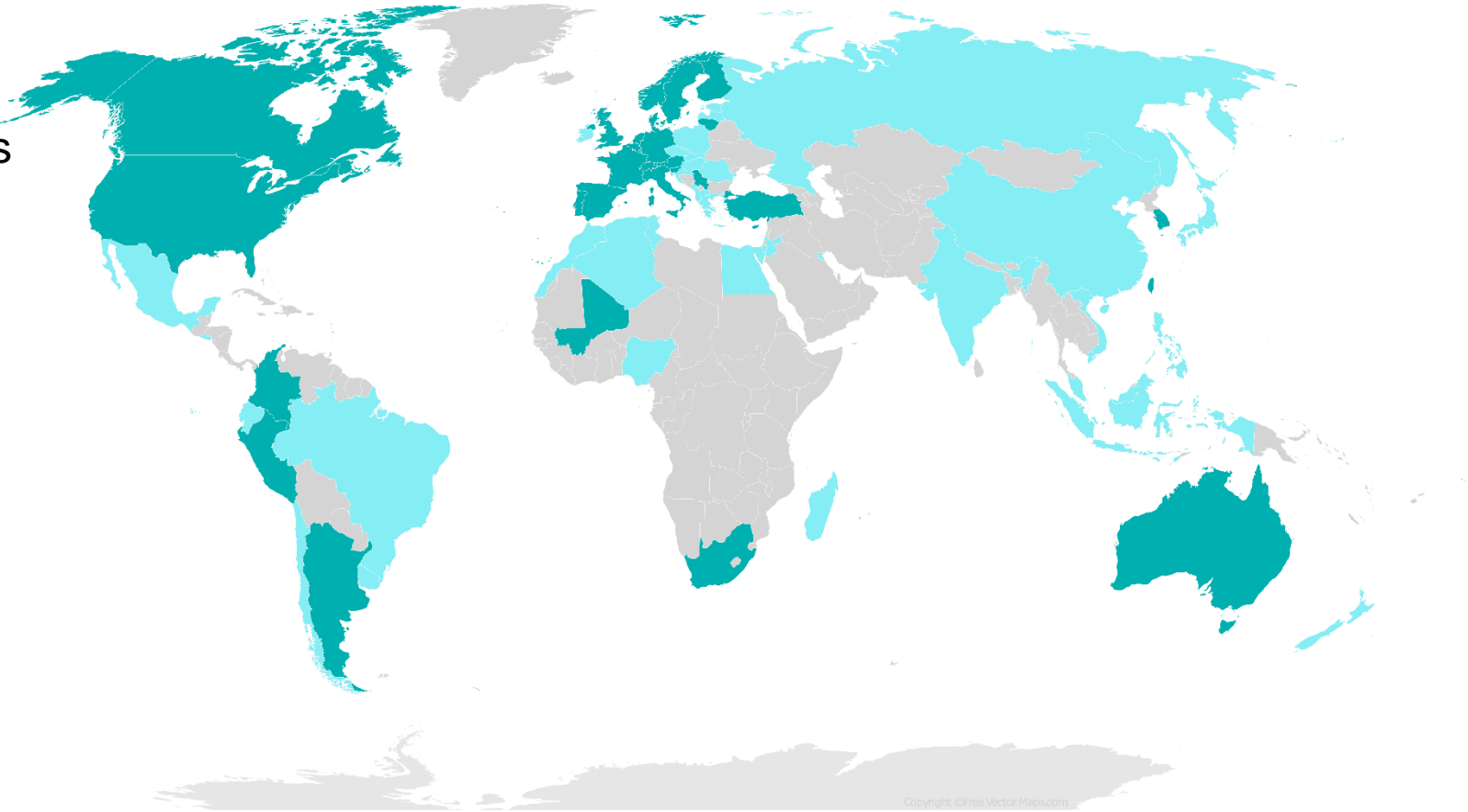

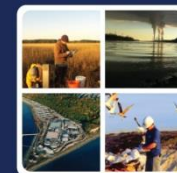

- ◆ ICCL is a worldwide network of regulators and policy makers
- ◆ Main meeting aim: informal exchange of know how and experiences between ICCL participants.

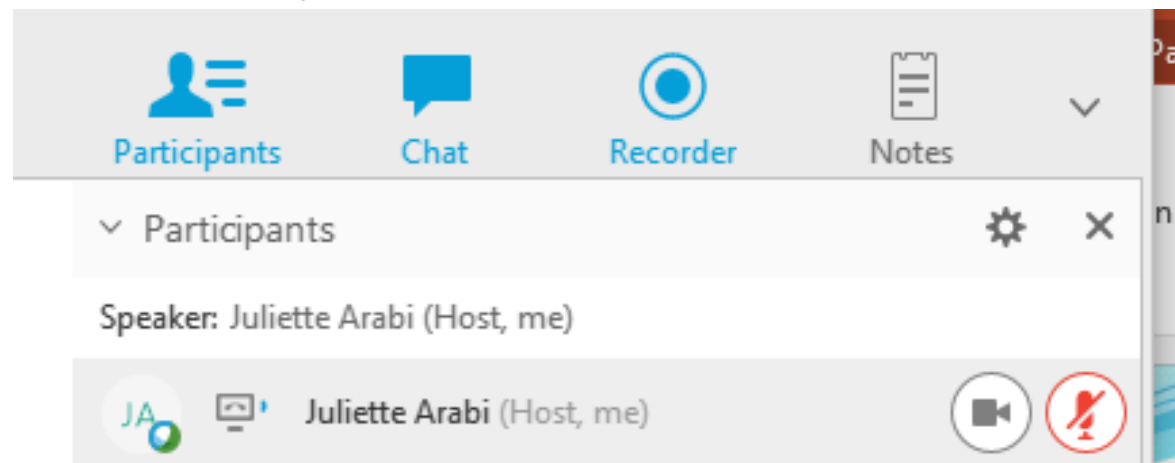
