#### Renewed soil protection Act

- Renewed soil protection Act in final phase in Parliamentary debate.
- New in the Act:
  - the obligation of soil remediation for industrial owners, combined with financial arrangements
  - aftercare
  - fit for use remediation

## Create a clean soil and healthy environment for all

- The users or owners of the site can link the remediation to their own investment plans
- The risk will be assessed by means of a tiered approach
- The overall goal is: create a clean soil and healthy environment for all

### Scale of soil pollution nationwide

- Several inventories of contaminated sites have been made
- The most recent estimate is that 600.000 sites are seriously contaminated
- 60.000 of them need remediation

#### General soil policy

- dec 2003 policy letter to parliament:
  - the various aspects of soil protection and management linked together, including biological and physical aspects
  - target: sustainable soil use
  - harmonising soil capacity and vulnerability with human use functions
  - holistic approach, integrating
    - spatial planning (including underground space),
    - water management,
    - urban development, nature and agriculture
    - regional projects

#### Excavated soil

- The policy document How to deal with contaminated excavated soil is presently under review.
- New elements:
  - Soil and sludge in one system
  - Reuse of soil/sludge not longer part of Building material decree
  - Nation wide soil management plans.
